

Lesson 2- HIV and Other STIs—Evaluating the Risks

- Objective: Students will be able to distinguish between the 5 different STIs
- Procedure-To be lectured on
 - What is an STI?
 - Sexually Transmitted Infection, formally known as an STD Sexually Transmitted Disease.
 - We will be talking about 5 different types of STIs. We will be talking about these because they are the most common, the most well known, and/or have the most serious implications.
 - Have the students form 4 groups.
 - Hand out four of the STI fact sheets and explain their task.
 - Students are to read about their STI and pick out the most important fact about their STI to present to the class.
 - Give students 10 minutes to do this.
 - Have the students present.
 - There are a total of 5 STIs presented in the lesson, so there will be no student presentation on one of the STIs
 - After the each student presentation explain more in detail about the 5 STIs from the handouts you gave the students
 - Read off those handouts
 - Discussion-If no discussion arises, pass out the worksheet.
- Assessment: Have student take home the worksheet for homework if they did not finish in class
 - Due the next time we have class.
