

Kindergarten Supply List

***PLEASE BRING ALL SUPPLIES TO OPEN HOUSE**

The following is a list of supplies that will be needed for your child in the classroom. Please read the back of this sheet.

Individual Supplies (please label)

- *1 Water bottle must be leak proof and non-spill
- *1 Backpack **NO WHEELS PLEASE!**
- *1 pair Scissors, blunt end (**Fiskars** brand works best)
- *2 **plastic** pocket folders
- *2 wide ruled 100 page composition notebooks (**write name on the front**)
- *1 Whiteboard eraser or sock
- *2 **Elmer's** glue stick (**Please no Dollar Store glue sticks. They dry up too quickly!**)
- *1- 12 pack of Crayola colored pencils
- *1 Plastic pencil box for supplies
- ***Change of clothes** - to be left in backpack in case of soiled clothing
- *Snow Gear - Only needed during the snowy season (snow pants, jacket, gloves, hat, scarf, and boots)

Communal Supplies (does not need to be labeled)

- *2 boxes of facial tissue
- *4 Clorox or Lysol Disinfecting wipes (bleach free)
- *12 **sharpened** #2 yellow Ticonderoga pencils
- *2 Pink Erasers, no pencil toppers
- *1 sandwich size ziploc slider bags
- *2 rolls of paper towel
- *24 **Elmer's** glue sticks (**Please no Dollar Store glue sticks. They dry up too quickly!**)
- *4 boxes of **Crayola** Crayons (**24 count** so your child can have a new box every quarter)



* Please no personal pencil sharpeners, no mechanical pencils and no pens. The items we requested are the things we need to have a successful year. Extra glue sticks, crayons and pencils will be stored at school to replenish when needed. We may be asking for other things to be replenished mid year.
